Bill Overview for Digital Opportunity



- 2.75 billion nationally for funding – we won't know our allocation until 2024
- State Planning Grants 60 million, state capacity 1.44 million, 1.25 million Capacity Grants
- Conducting stakeholder engagement to determine needs and assets
 - Listening sessions with stakeholders and orgs representing stakeholders
 - DO Plan public comment period closed, received good feedback
- Potential Focuses – have current wish list of how funding may be used once allocations are received.
 - Mike – digital citizenship – want people online, not standing in line – we have shifted government services to online portals, want to have citizens who can use these tools
 - Want Tribes to train citizens to be good remote workers, can help with job access

Kim – Internet for All Bipartisan Infrastructure and Jobs Bill

- SD allocated for BEAD, DE, Tribal, but did not receive Middle Mile allocations
- BEAD Timeline
 - End 2023 - letters of intent received from all states
 - 5 Year Plans submitted by states
 - IP drafts submitted for public comment – due 12/27
 - Challenge process early 2024
- BEAD priority is unserved locations
- Digital Equity, Opportunity
 - State Planning Portion
 - Plans to apply for state capacity grants
 - Competitive grants coming as well
- Stakeholders are critical
- Digital Equity Act – 8 covered populations

Margaret – Consultations for BEAD

- Engaging tribal entities is required for BEAD and to make sure tribes are being covered
- Talking through locations not listed on the maps, don't always even have address available
- If Tribal grants are in place, what are the shortfalls, how are funds being used? Where are the current funds being used?

Margaret – TCBP

- TCBP – round 2 – 980 million dollars left
- Expand broadband adoption and deployment on tribal lands - closed on Jan 23/24
- Eligible Lands/Entities
- Round 2 prioritizes tribes that did not receive round 1 or other funds
- 4 year award period timeline – have to be approved by assistant secretary to go beyond 4 years
- Stand alone projects no longer eligible
- Infrastructure Deployment projects prioritized
- De-duplication and challenge process part of round 2
- Cyber security and supply chain requirements, shape files now required for all applicants
- 6 categories come ahead of anyone who got round 1 TCBP
- Cannot duplicate current federal fund or satellite use
- Tribal Broadband Leaders Network – meet monthly and put on webinars
 - Email tbln@ntia.gov to get added
- Can build their own ISP under infrastructure – but need a shovel ready plan – won't see much of that for round 2

Mike – questions for tribes

- Talk to us about current funds and how they are being used
- Do you need help with plan – our plans and info are out and available
- Subgrantee? – review Vol 1 and 2 for requirements of BEAD to understand the application
- ISPs – talk to us if ISPs are operating on tribal lands but not with up to date consent to operate
 - We don't care where the location is, we want to know what locations need connecting
- Who is the best person to coordinate for your tribal area? Contacts are helpful

Randy Hughes – Oglala



- Sent Oglala Consultation Ordinance to SD.
 - Per ordinance, Tribal President needs to request a consultation formally
 - Funding for wireless network received for Oglala, currently have wireless service
 - Mapping done by Oglala estimates 1,600 BSLs missed by FCC mapping data, locations that need to be added.
 - Oglala has strong desire to consult, but formal Ordinance process must be adhered to in order to set up a consultation

Mike – we do have work to do with de-duplication of locations.

- Happy to work with tribes on mapping and FCC updates and info.
- BSL locations like rural farms that have a house, but also want fiber to other parts of their land to monitor cattle, other buildings or aspects of farm/ranch process
- SD would love to have a direct IT contact in each tribal area to engage with
- Look forward to continued conversation
